

In 1840, Polish explorer Pawel Strzelecki ventured into South East Victoria and found forests, rolling hills, rivers and land suitable for grazing. He named the area Gippsland after the then Governor of NSW, George Gipps.

Settlers followed and the area soon became a prosperous region and remains so today with agricultural pursuits, dotted with interesting villages. A number of National and State Parks preserve the habitat as Strzelecki found it.
