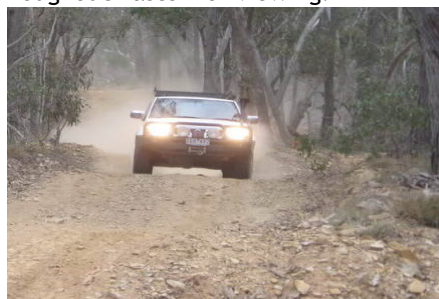
We have plenty of toilets but only five showers. Avoid the queues - BYO shower.

Generators are not permitted at the reserve. There are still some powered sites available. Due to limited capacity, a reminder that power is for refrigeration, lighting and water pumps only - no microwaves, toasters, jugs, hair driers etc.
